Our work schedule is typically Monday to Friday with an average of 100hr pay periods. We pay OT after 100 hrs. We ask that you come to work willing and ready each and every day and work to the best of your ability. Requirements:

- Possess a valid Class 1 driver's license with air and clean drivers abstract.
- Demonstrated work experience as a Class 1 Driver and equipment hauling, using a 45' deck trailer.
- Practical experience with electronic/cellular equipment and software.
- Ability to drive long hours and travel regularly.
- Extensive knowledge of applicable truck driving rules and regulations.
- Adaptability and foresight to handle unexpected situations (traffic, weather conditions etc.).
- Mechanical skills to correctly identify equipment issues.
