Under the direction of the Civil Construction Supervisor and/or Senior Tradesperson, will perform civil construction work at the Journeyperson level with minimal supervision.

Responsibilities:

- Perform complex carpentry work, concrete forming, placing reinforcing steel/anchor bolts and concrete, concrete finishing, and wood frame and metal building erection.
- Effectively interpret technical drawings and specifications for construction projects.
- Install: fencing, grounding, conduits, oil containment systems, drainage systems as per drawings and specifications.
- Perform leadership for all crew members for safe, efficient, and effective work.
- Estimate construction costs and safely, effectively plan/schedule work with supervisors and personnel as required.
- Prepare safety job plans, tailboards and conduct safety meetings.
- Perform all survey work necessary for civil construction, including accurate use of both transit and level for site layout.
- Operate power tools and general construction equipment.
- Perform and manage the organization and care of crew tools and equipment.
- Order and receive project materials and complete the necessary paperwork.
- Assist in the development of work procedures and communicate these to the crew members.
- Work in active substations and in the presence of foundations, structures, apparatus, overhead structures, and underground utilities.
- Direct other staff performing similar work ensuring satisfactory completion.
- Foster a positive working environment amongst crew members.
- Interact with various internal/external work groups for planning, coordination, and execution of the work.
- Work inside/outside 12 months of the year 95% of the time in all weather conditions for extended periods.
- Adhere to and practice Manitoba Hydro Corporate Safety & Occupational Health Rules and regulations regarding WHMIS, TDG, Traffic control, Worker Protection Code, Safe Work Procedures and Life Saving Rules as they apply to construction activity.

Qualifications:

- Minimum Grade 10 education, a Manitoba Certificate of Qualification as a Carpenter Journeyperson, plus up to one year of directly related experience working in energized switchyards.
- Physically capable of performing all the duties of the position.
- Ability to interpret written and verbal instructions, specifications, and drawings of construction projects.
- Exhibit leadership qualities and willingness to assist and train junior staff in development.
- Possess an approved set of personal hand tools.
- Capable of using a builder's transit and level.
- Demonstrated ability in the operation of certified equipment such as skid steers and excavators required for the work.

- Willing and able to work anywhere in Manitoba for extended periods of time.
- Has and maintains in good standing a valid Manitoba Class 5 driver's licence.
